## Provide strong routines

 Routines described as a, "shared socially scripted patterns of behavior, serving to reduce the cognitive complexity of the instructional environment."

Routines help establish and rehearse procedures for instruction to continue fluidly and efficiently. (Leinhardt,

G., Weidman, C & Hammond, K. M. 1987)

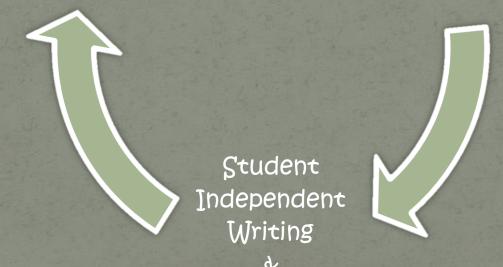

# Lesson Structure and Pacing

## Provide appropriate tools

• Vygotskian approach of using tools or strategies to support the development of early literacy, including meta-cognitive and meta-linguistic skills to build foundational literacy skills. (Bodrova, E., & Leong, D. J., 2006)

#### Cultural Tool Theory

Stage 1

- Learning occurs through multiple repetitions
- Establishing daily routine formats, ex. Writer's Workshop

Stage 2

- Introduction to symbols and tools specific to context
- Modeling and using scaffolding materials

Stage 3

- Use of tools becomes independent; Tools seen as external mediators
- Modeled writing charts

Stage 4

- Internalization of information occurs
- No use for external tools

# Provide an environment of encouragement and support

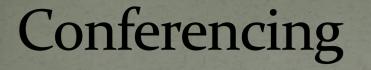
Teaching is not about the management of students to create an orderly classroom.

Teaching is about building relationships with students to create a culture of learning.

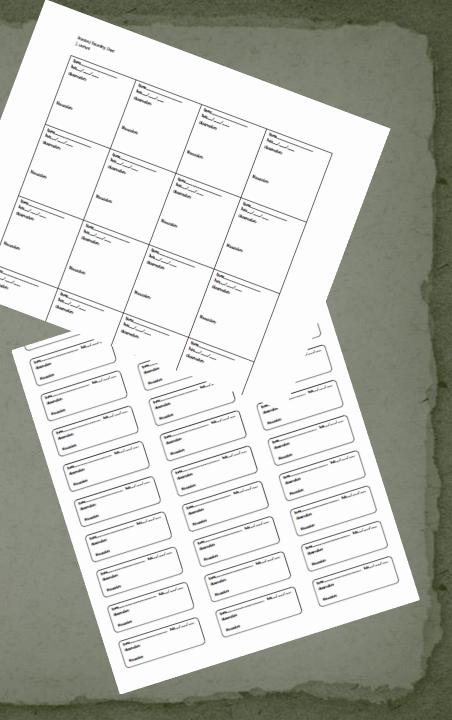
